



Program Description

IRIC, an ultra-modern research hub located in the heart of Université de Montréal, was created in 2003 to shed light on the mechanisms of cancer, discover new therapies and train the next generation of scientists.

IRIC is home to 29 research units led by world-class principal investigators fully committed to cancer research and to training the next generation of research leaders. Students have access to many graduate programs and exciting research projects that can be grouped into 7 areas of research: Cell Signaling & Protein Dynamics / Cell Division & Migration / Immunology & Hematopoiesis / Genomics & Epigenetics / Chemical & Structural Biology / Targeted Therapies & Diagnostics / Computational Analysis & Modeling.

Cancer is a complex disease, caused by multiple cellular dysregulations. For many years, the problem has been addressed by studying one single gene or one single function at a time, but in the age of genomics and proteomics, a growing number of Investigators are now studying cancer as a whole by combining new techniques with a multidisciplinary approach.

It was with a view to training the next generation of scientists for these new approaches that IRIC set up research training in Systems Biology, a unique study program at IRIC. The training, developed by our Investigators and using the various core facilities available at the Institute, fits in perfectly with the multidisciplinary and collaborative approach put forth by IRIC.

Program Description

The graduate student training program is a vital component of the Department of Medical Biophysics, dating back more than 50 years to its origins in cancer research at the Ontario Cancer Institute.

The department offers interdisciplinary research-focused graduate studies at both the Masters (MSc) and PhD level. The MSc program is a common entry point, but the emphasis is on the PhD program. Course work is intended to broaden the backgrounds of all students, most of whom enter with undergraduate training in the life or physical sciences.

Research principally takes place in the biomedical and cancer research institutes of the major teaching hospitals at the University of Toronto, rather than in University labs. These include the Princess Margaret Cancer Centre, Sunnybrook Research Institute, the Hospital for Sick Children Research Institute, Toronto General Hospital Research Institute, Rotman/Baycrest Research Institute, the Lunenfeld-Tanenbaum Research Institute, Techna Institute and the Ontario Institute for Cancer Research. The resources and facilities provided by these institutions are unmatched in Canada, as is research productivity: a recent five year review listed 3,933 peer-reviewed papers published by our faculty and students, which had already accrued 64,300 citations in the scientific literature.

Interdisciplinary research is at the heart of the department of Medical Biophysics, cutting across the conventional boundaries of physics, engineering, chemistry, mathematics, biology and medicine. Graduate studies in our department focuses on both basic and translational research, and our graduates hold leading positions in fields ranging from Academia, Pharma & Biotechnology to Government, Education and Professional practice (Medicine, Law and Business).

University of Toronto, Department of Speech-Language Pathology

Program Description

The Department of Speech-Language Pathology was established at the University of Toronto in 1958 with the creation of a two-year postgraduate diploma program, the first of its kind in English in Canada. In 1978, a Master of Health Science (MHSc) degree was established to replace the diploma program. The establishment of an independent Department of Speech-Language Pathology and the subsequent introduction of MSc and PhD programs followed the development of this degree.

Currently, the fully accredited MHSc program is a national and international leader in professional education and research in speech-language pathology.

Speech-language pathologists (SLPs) are professionals educated in the study of human communication and swallowing, with knowledge regarding typical development and disorders. By assessing the speech, language, cognitive communication and swallowing skills of children and adults, the speech-language pathologist determines what communication or swallowing challenges exist and the best way to treat them. SLPs also collaborate with other health and related professionals. Areas of focus include disorders of:

- Developmental language
- Neurogenic speech and language
- Fluency, voice and hearing
- Articulation/phonology
- Swallowing
- Alternative and augmentative communication

The Department of Speech-Language Pathology, Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto offers a unique, integrated and effective curriculum in its full-time 22-month MHSc program. This modular curriculum was designed to bridge the gap between the theoretical knowledge learned in the classroom and its practical application in today's demanding and evolving work environments. Academic courses are grouped into theme-related units, followed by clinical placements in that area. This enables students to immediately apply and consolidate recent academic learning in a practical setting. Additionally, clinical placements are full-time, allowing students to devote all their attention to practical work. Learning is also reinforced across academic and clinical units through the research-to-practice focus and ongoing communication with clinical educators. Students correspondingly participate in the innovative Interprofessional Education (IPE) Curriculum at the University of Toronto.

University of Toronto, Master of Engineering (MEng), Mechanical & Industrial Engineering

Program Description

The Master of Engineering program provides graduate students with advanced professional training through coursework and an optional project.

MIE's MEng program provides graduate students with the tools to succeed in professional practice. The program consists of coursework and an optional project conducted under the supervision of an MIE faculty member. Students have the option to complete the MEng program on a full-time, extended full-time or part-time basis


