To get to the Student Life Room:



1. Enter the Student Commons entrance facing Huron Street.

2. Go down the main hallway past the UTSU Commons Help Desk to the back doors. You will enter the elevator by passing through two sets of doors to the back right corner of the main floor.





3. Enter the elevator and press the fifth floor (5) button.



4. Exit the elevator and pass through doors straight ahead. From the stairs, you will be just in front of the door you'll need to enter. The door will have a label next to it that says "Floor 5 Stair C" as pictured below.





5. Enter Room 556 or 558 to enter the Student Life Room.
